

GPA SUPPLY LIST – Middle School

Grace Preparatory Academy, 2023-24 School Year

NOTE: Students who are enrolled only in choir and/or art do NOT need to purchase the general supplies. They will only need class-specific supplies listed later in this document.

NOTE: Students are responsible to check and replenish their supplies throughout the year!

GENERAL SUPPLIES FOR ALL MIDDLE SCHOOL CLASSES

Backpack or over-the-shoulder book bag

- Do not purchase a rolling suitcase; these are not suitable for our campus. However, if your backpack has wheels, that is acceptable.
- Some students prefer to have one backpack for M/W classes and a separate backpack for T/Th classes. However, this is not mandatory.
- Your individual teachers will specify which textbooks to bring to class in your backpack and which books to keep at home.

School Binder(s)

- *Students with a M/W schedule:* one 1-½" 3-ring binder
- *Students with a T/Th schedule:* one 1-½" 3-ring binder
- These will be central binders for all paperwork brought to/from classes each day.
- **NOTE: If you prefer to have a separate binder per class instead of a M/W binder and a T/Th binder, you may do so. Be aware this may result in a heavy and over-full backpack.**

Purchase the following items for your School Binder:

- One pocket portfolio folder per class (see picture).
 - o **Purchase a different color for each class.**
 - o Buy folders with 3 holes so you can insert them into your binder.
 - o Any brand will do, but plastic may hold up better through the year.
- Check the class-specific supply lists on the following pages. Teachers may specify items for the binder (tabbed dividers, page protectors...)



OTHER GENERAL SUPPLIES:

Loose-leaf wide-rule notebook paper, replenished throughout the year. **NO SPIRAL NOTEBOOKS.**

Supply box or pouch, containing the following:

- Pencils (2-3 with erasers)
- Pens (2-3; black or blue only)
- Red pen for correcting (*6th graders only*)
- Highlighter (no-bleed brand such as Ticonderoga Emphasis)
- Plastic post-it tabs (see picture -- any brand is acceptable, but please purchase the plastic variety because it is more reliably adhesive than the paper variety.)



ITEMS FOR USE AT HOME:

- Dictionary (*recommend a Student Dictionary suitable for grades 6-9*)
- Thesaurus (can be an online resource)
- Bible
- Ruler
- Poster boards (*teachers may ask for these; please wait to purchase until an assignment is given*)
- *Recommended:* Keep a binder or file at home for each class to store homework, etc.

- NOTE: Mrs. Wilburn will purchase a sketchbook for each student. A \$3.50 incidental charge will appear on your first FACTS tuition statement.*

- 6 tabbed dividers labeled: Root, Prefix, Suffix, Rough Draft, Handouts, Notes
