These courses are required for receiving a diploma from Grace Preparatory Academy. The listing below is a suggestion for the order of necessary classes.

Freshman Year:

Math Geometry or Algebra I (Alg. I taken in 8th grade counts for H.S. credit)

English Pre-AP English I or II

Social Studies Geography
Science Pre-AP Biology

Foreign Language I or II (Language I taken in 8th grade counts for H.S. credit)

Other Speech, P.E., Fine Arts

Electives Bible

Sophomore Year:

Math Algebra II or Geometry English Pre-AP English II or I Social Studies History (U.S. or World)

Science Chemistry (may wait to take chemistry in another year)

Foreign Language II or III

Other any still needed for 1 P.E., 1 Fine Arts, Speech

Electives Bible, Driver Ed.

Junior Year:

Math Pre-Calculus or Algebra II

English AP English Literature & Composition

Social Studies History (World or U.S.)

Science Physics (optional for graduates of 2018 or beyond)

Other any still needed for 1 P.E., 1 Fine Arts, Speech Electives any needed to complete the elective credits

Senior Year:

Math Calculus or Pre-Calculus (or other math course for graduates of 2018 or

beyond)

English AP English Language & Composition

Social Studies Government (full year at Grace Prep) **and** Economics (1 semester) Science Suitable 4th-year options—Anatomy & Physiology, Marine Biology,

Astronomy, Earth & Space Science, or Environmental Systems

Electives College Prep, any others still needed for 5 ½ credits

Every student receiving a Grace Preparatory diploma must have credits for the following classes:

4 math, 4 science, 4 English, 4 social studies, 2 foreign language, 1 P.E., 1 Fine Arts, ½ speech, and 5½ elective classes for a total of 26 credits.

Math must include algebra I, geometry, and algebra II.

Science must include biology and chemistry (the 3rd & 4th years allow for options) If a third year of foreign language is taken, then only 4 ½ elective credits are needed.
