## **ALL MIDDLE AND HIGH SCHOOL ART CLASSES**

\*A portable container for carrying your supplies (Any plastic container will do. Fishing tackle boxes are great because of the compartments and removable trays. WalMart and Hobby Lobby also have art supply boxes in their arts/crafts aisles)

\*SPIRAL Bound Sketchbook approximately 9" x 11" (larger is fine, but not smaller).

\*Magic rub vinyl eraser

\*#2 Pencils with erasers (like Ticonderoga, not mechanical)

\*Hand-held pencil sharpener

\*Elmer's Glue-All 16 oz

Sharpie ultra-fine marker - black

Sharpie fine point marker - black

Small set of Micron Pens

A small sponge (kitchen sponge or a natural ocean artist sponge, either is fine)

A cheap soft bristled toothbrush

A Set of 8 or more Watercolors

Set of 3 or more artist paint brushes in various sizes (Some round & some flat in different widths)

Palette knife

Ruler (non-skid if possible but not required)

Scissors 7"

An inexpensive clay tool set (\$3 or less)

For the classroom (you can bring on orientation night):

**BOYS** - 1 roll of .94 inch painter's tape **GIRLS** - 2 rolls of paper towels **ANYONE** - old magazines & newspapers

## **MIDDLE SCHOOL ART**

\*1 (Size 28" x 22") Poster Board, any color

(You can bring on orientation night. Be sure and put name on it with pencil.)

\*Crayola Broad Line Washable Markers - A set of at least 8 colors

Small tubes or bottles of Acrylic Paint (ok if bought in a set):

1 each of red, orange, yellow, green, blue, purple, black, brown 2 of white

Set of 12 or more Colored Pencils

## **HIGH SCHOOL ART 1, 2 & 3**

Set of 12 or more Soft or Chalk Pastels

Drawing pencils (4H, 2H, F, B, 3B, 5B, 7B)

Set of 24 or more Prismacolor Pencils

Eraser Pencil(s) - These are actual pencils with erasers in the core instead of lead. Great for precision erasing!

A blending stump and a small piece of sandpaper for sharpening

2oz tubes of heavy body Acrylic Paint (ok if bought in a set):

1 each of red, orange, yellow, green, blue, purple, black, brown 2 of white

Optional: 1 Red Wallet Portfolio with handles 20" x 26". It's a nice way to transport & store your artwork.

(If you want to get one of these be sure and have your name on it in BLACK Sharpie)
